[1] Tuesday, December 20, 2022 was a historic day for all Moroccans. Morocco's national football team received a hero's welcome upon their return home after finishing fourth at the FIFA World Cup Qatar 2022. This achievement seemed to be impossible at the beginning of the tournament. However, the Moroccan team, known as the Atlas Lions, made history after becoming the first one in the region to reach the semifinals of a World Cup.



[2] After their plane landed at Rabat airport, the players rode an open-top bus through the major streets of the capital accompanied by dozens of police cars and motorbikes with flashing lights. More than 8,000 police officers secured the roads that the bus took. Thousands of joyous fans lined up along the streets. They waved flags, set off fireworks, danced to the beat of drums and greeted the players. Smiling players and their coach Walid Regragui waved, blew kisses and took selfies with the fans.

[3] His majesty, King Mohammed VI, received the national football team with their mothers at the royal palace in Rabat to celebrate their historic accomplishment. The country's national news agency MAP reported that mothers were received in recognition of their efforts to "instill in their children the values of patriotism, sacrifice and national belonging". The king awarded all team members the "Order of the Throne", a national Wissam.

[4] During this event, Morocco defeated big teams such as Belgium, Spain and Portugal. Along the way, the Atlas Lions earned plenty of respect and admiration for their artistic skills, energy, strong defense and attack. In addition to that, the football team showed the whole world values of motherhood, family ties and cultural identity. Players waved the Moroccan and Palestinian flags, did Sajdah, and danced with their mothers and children after their wins.



[5] Political leaders, sports stars and celebrities used social media to congratulate Morocco for its achievement. "Proud of the lions! Proud of the performance!" wrote Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid, Ruler of Dubai. Entrepreneur and billionaire Elon Musk took to Twitter to celebrate the Atlas Lions' victory. "Congrats Morocco!" he wrote. The Colombian singer Shakira greeted Morocco's latest World Cup performance. "This time for Africa," she tweeted, referring to her famous South Africa World Cup 2010 song "WakaWaka". Samuel Eto'o, the former

Cameroon striker and current president of the country's football federation, said on Twitter: "Incredible! ...The entire continent is rooting for you."
